## AGREEMENT about joint organization of a scientific conference

- **4.** University of Economy and Innovation in Lublin (WSEI), represented by prof. PhD. **Sylwester Bogacki**, Dean of the Faculty of Administration and Social Sciences,(coorganizer)
- 5. National Institute for Economic Research (Republic of Moldova), represented by Director PhD Alexandr Stratan and head of Department Financial and Monetary Research PhD Rodica Perciun (technical co-organizer)

The organizer and the co-organizers have made an agreement regarding the holding of the tenth scientific conference in the premises of the Faculty of Business and Tourism Budva, Montenegro "on the topic:

"International technology cooperation, trade and innovation in supply chain after the Covid-19 pandemic"

The main contents / sectoral topics within the main cognitive direction could be found by the authors in the following indents:

- > A new economy in light of the changes caused by the pandemic
- > Innovation and economic development during a pandemic
- > Innovation and entrepreneurship conditioned by pandemic circumstances
- > Innovations in public and other health care systems
- > Sectoral innovations in today's pandemic circumstances: manufacturing, trade, services
- Organizational innovations tourism, catering, traffic
- > Demographic trends, pandemics and demographic policy innovations
- > Risk management in pandemic and post-pandemic conditions
- > Protecting the environment and natural resources is a (post) fall challenge
- > Software industry, pandemic and post-pandemic projections

## II

The organizer (Oikos Institute) and co-organizers (Faculty of Business and Tourism Budva, West Ukrainian National University, University of Economy and Innovation in Lublin (WSEI) and National Institute for Economic Research (Republic of Moldova), agreed that the scientific conference will be held on May 27, 2022. in Budva in the premises of the Faculty of Business and Tourism Budva Montenegro, in the presence of domestic and foreign authors by invitation.

The organizer and co-organizers have the obligation to jointly advertise, promote and invite as many participants as possible, domestic and foreign origin, with the obligatory posting of a link to the invitation to the scientific conference on their websites.

## IV

The organizer and co-organizers agreed that the co-organizer (Faculty of Business and Tourism Budva) provide a gathering space for IT specialists, translators and photographers. The co-organizer (Faculty of Business and Tourism Budva) participates in the organization of accommodation, and all accommodation costs are borne by the organizer and co-organizers for their representatives. The technical co-organizer (National Institute for Economic Research) with the organizer of this meeting, will be an integral part of this agreement.

The co-organizers of the Western Ukrainian National University of Ukraine, the University of Economics and Innovation in Lublin (VSEI) and the National Institute for Economic Research (Republic of Moldova) are required to submit at least 5 papers by different authors, regardless of their country of origin. direct them to the name of the topic of the scientific meeting and to determine their plenary speaker.

The same rules apply to the fourth and fifth co-organizers, who will be an integral part of this agreement.

For all authors brought by the organizer and co-organizer, the income from participation belongs to the organizer. The costs of publishing papers are borne by the organizer of the conference (Institute).

V

The agreement enters into force on the day of signing.

VI

In case of a dispute, these issues will be resolved before the competent court.

VII

The Agreement is made in 6 identical copies, of which each party keeps 2 copies.
